Comprising the following:

- A. Portion of the Government Land of Makua.
- B. Portion of the Railroad Right-of-Way in Waianae, as described in Item 6 of Schedule A with Grant Deed of the Territory of Hawaii to Oahu Railway and Land Company, dated April 29, 1903, recorded in Liber 249 on Pages 160-167 (Land Office Deed 939) and returned to the State of Hawaii by Oahu Railway and Land Company by Quiteclaim Deed, dated September 11, 1961 and recorded in Liber 4135, Pages 239-240 (Land Office Deed S-18222).

Beginning at the northeast corner of this parcel of land and on the west side of Farrington Highway, the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "MAKUA 2" being 2974.80 feet North and 1386.80 feet West, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. 349° 54' 895.03 feet along the west side of Farrington Highway;
2. Thence along the west side of Farrington Highway on a curve to the right with a radius of 1929.86 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
2° 57' 30" 872.08 feet;
3. 16° 01' 48.10 feet along the west side of Farrington Highway;
4. Thence along the west side of Farrington Highway on a curve to the left with a radius of 1939.86 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
7° 59' 45" 541.35 feet;
5. 359° 58' 30" 391.87 feet along the west side of Farrington Highway;
6. 100° 20' 270.00 feet along the boundary between the Lands of Makua and Ohikilolo to highwater mark at seashore;

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Thence along highwater mark at seashore for the next three (3) courses, the direct azimuths and distances between points on said highwater mark being:

- 7. 179° 00' 1720.00 feet;
- 8. 119° 30' 225.00 feet;
- 9. 176° 00' 860.00 feet to the top of the south bank of Koiahi Stream

Thence along the top of the south bank of Koiahi Stream, the direct azimuth and distance being:

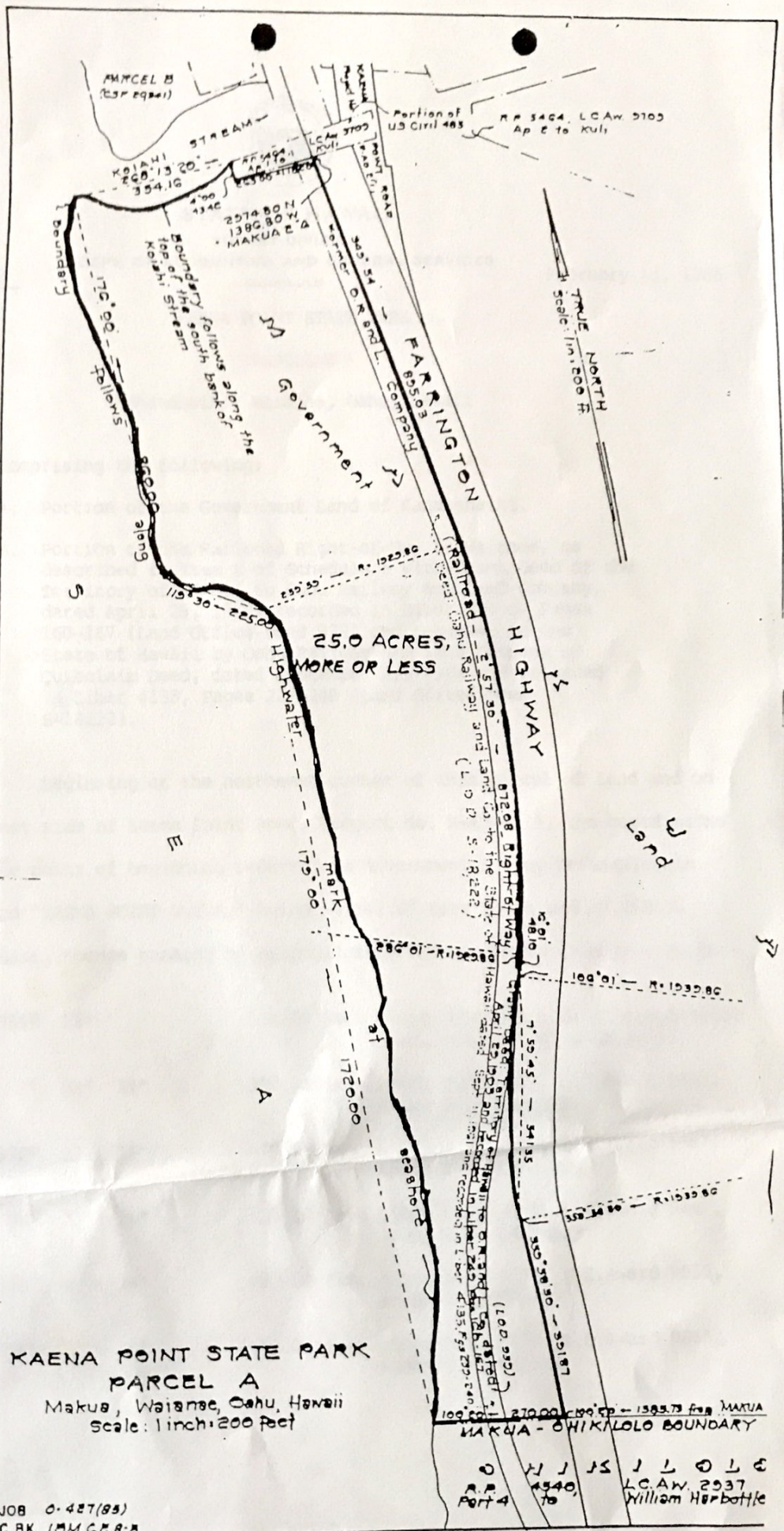

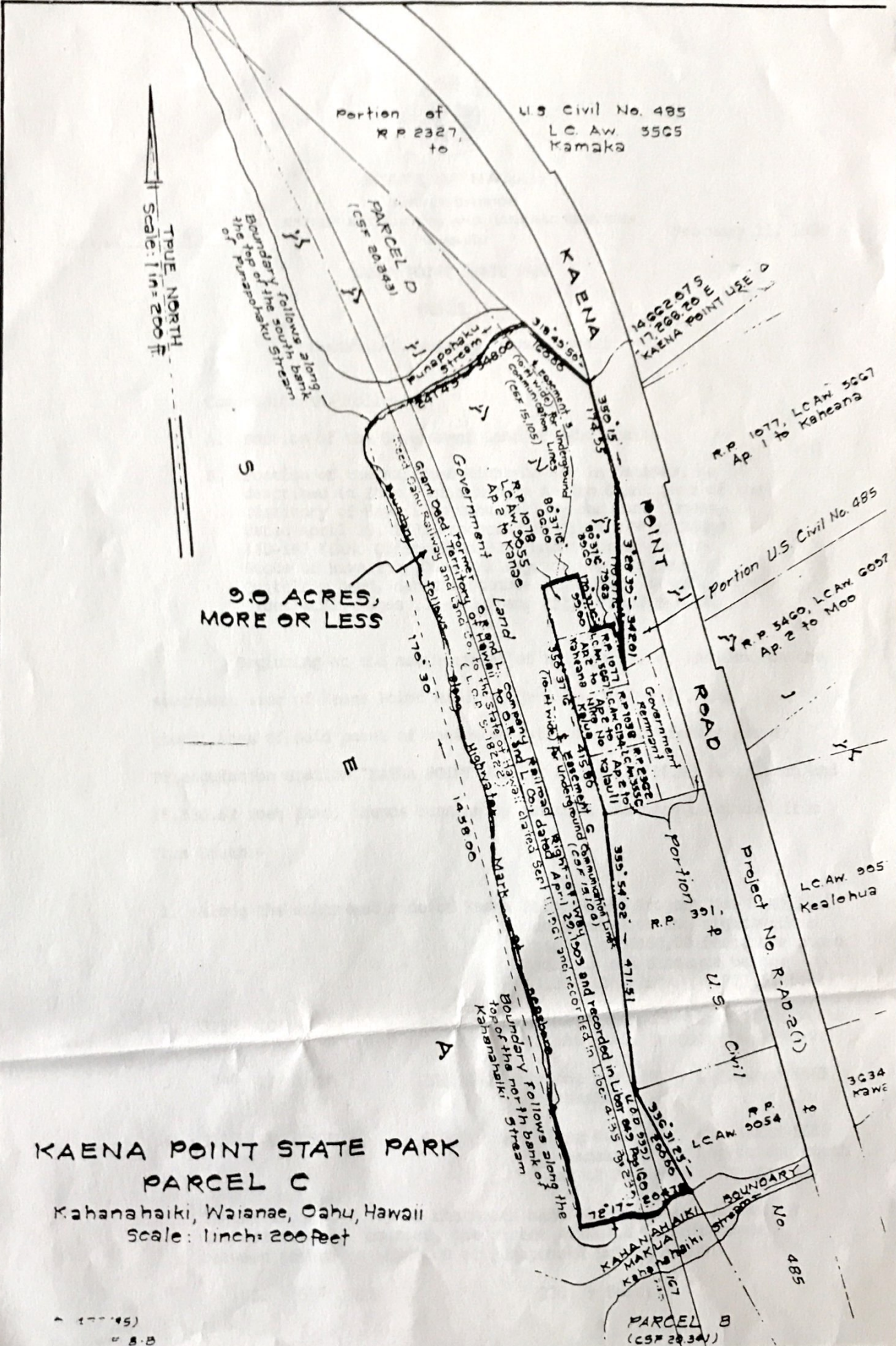

Beginning at the north corner of this parcel of land and on the southwest side of Kaena Point Road, Project No. R-AD 2(1), the coordinates of said point of beginning referred to Government Survey Triangulation Station "KAENA POINT U.S.E." being 12,634.03 feet South and 15,530.62 feet East, thence running by azimuths measured clockwise from True South:-

1. Along the southwest side of Kaena Point Road, Project No. R-AD 2(1) on a curve to the right with a radius of 6960.00 feet, the chord azimuth and distance being:
312° 10' 15" 727.51 feet;
2. 315° 10' 986.47 feet along the southwest side of Kaena Point Road, Project No. R-AD-2(1);
3. 79° 11' 52" 202.19 feet along R.P. 2327, L.C.Award 5565 to Kamaka;
4. 318° 49' 50" 850.00 feet along R.P. 2327, L.C.Award 5565 to Kamaka to the top of the north bank of Punapohaku Stream;

Thence along the top of the north bank of Punapohaku Stream for the next two (2) courses, the direct azimuths and distances between points on said top of Punapohaku Stream being:

5. 55° 00' 230.39 feet;

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6. 124° 00' 167.47 feet to highwater mark at seashore;

Thence along highwater mark at seashore for the next four (4) courses, the direct azimuths and distances between points on said highwater mark being:

10. 128° 00' 505.00 feet;

11. 219° 10' 30" 40.00 feet along Parcel E of Kaena Point State Park to the point of beginning and containing an AREA OF 7.0 ACRES, MORE OR LESS.

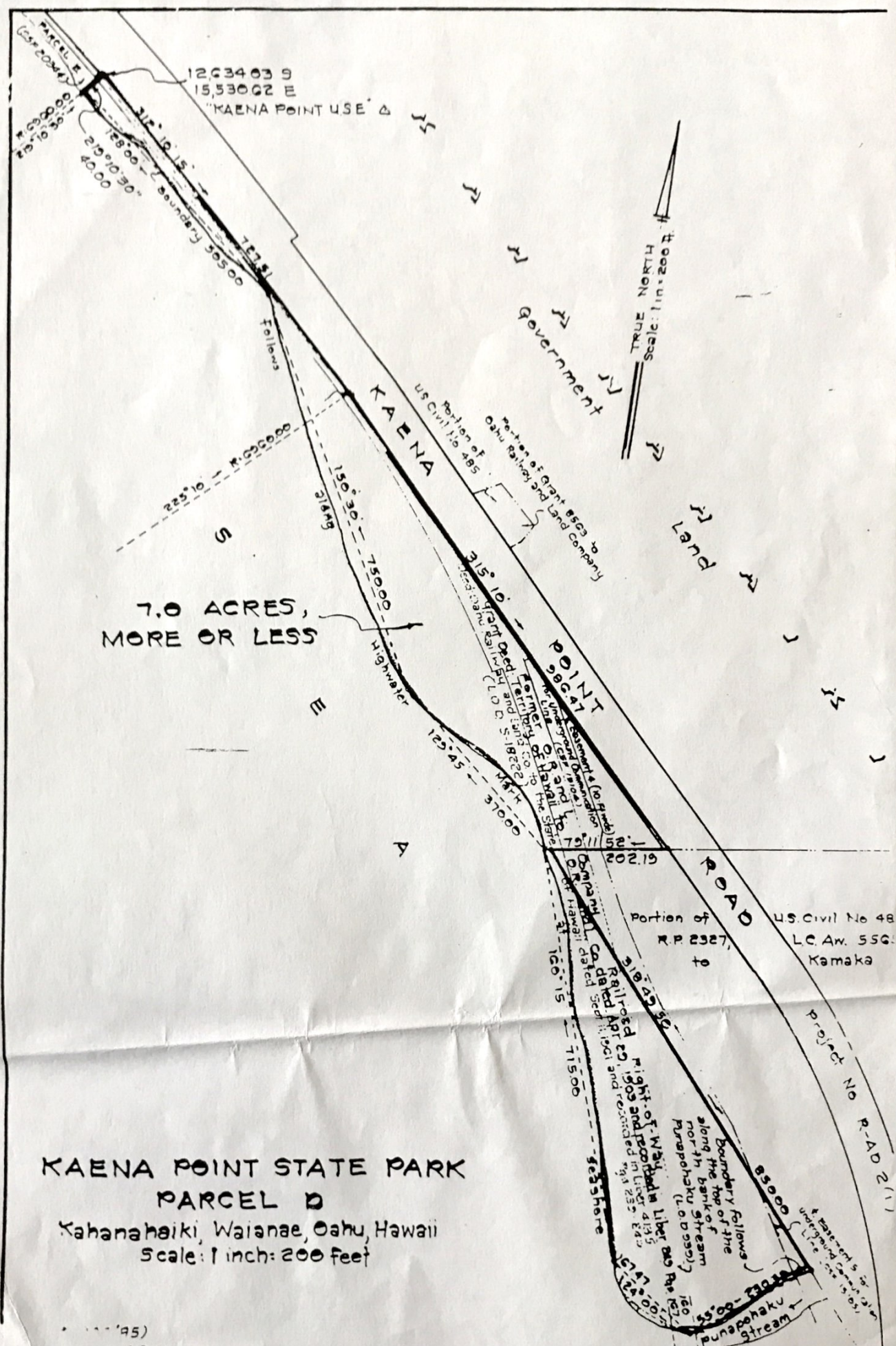
